Cartiere di Trevi - highlights

- Cartiere di Trevi S.p.A. was founded in 1960
- It is the only paper mill located in Umbria
- All products are made exclusively with recycled raw material

Total production62,000 ton / year

Waste paper used 70,000 ton / year

Market85% Italy / I 5% abroad





The products

- Paper and cardboard for corrugators used in the packaging sector
- Grey cardboard used for tubes and sheets
- Coloured cardboards used for stationary items, interlayers, place mats
- Laminated cardboards used for the food packaging





Separate collection of paper and cardboard

- In Italy every minute I 0 tons of waste paper are collected
- Average domestic collection per person: 53 kg/year
- Total domestic separate collection of waste paper : 6.3 mln ton/
 year
- Waste paper collection trend: +3% vs previous year
- Average collection of waste paper in Umbria per person: 63.5 kg/ year
- Separate collection Umbria: 57,320 ton/year



Circularity in the paper industry

Waste paper is the first source of fibre for paper production. It can be used up to 7 times.

The paper industry registers one of the highest circularity rates in the Italian industry.

The average circularity rate in the **paper industry** is **55**% with a **peak of 80**% in the **packaging** sector.

The average circularity rate of the entire Italian industry is about 17.8%.



The paper cycle

Objectives:

- The valorisation of waste paper from the Umbrian territory, through its transformation into resources.
- The recycling within the same territory of the separate collection of paper and cardboard
- The reduction of CO₂ emissions related to the transport of waste paper to other regions
- The increase of the separate collection thanks to awareness campaigns towards the citizines

Valle Umbria Servizi is our partner in this project delivering every year approx. 5,000 tons of waste paper to Cartiere di Trevi plant directly from the 'house to house' collection.



Beyond the paper cycle

The processing waste



- It is the non-recyclable part of the collection of paper and cardboard
- It derives from the mistakes that citizens make in differentiating waste
- It is essentially composed of plastic, contains metal, glass and sand parts
- The percentage of impurities is approximately **3,46**% (I)
- These "impurities", at the end of the pulping phase, are separated from the paper fibres and constitute the main waste of the production process



High technology

- The new pulp preparation plant and the press for waste treatment ensure the maximum recovering of the material
- The pulper waste is then COMPACTED and DEHYDRATED
- The percentage of **HUMIDITY** contained in the waste is strongly reduced reaching an average of **30**%
- It is classified CER 030307 according to Euregulations


