- Estonia's first railway-line was built from Paldiski to St.Petersburg in 1870
- Soviet Red Army occupied Paldiski in 1939
- Paldiski remained stricktly closed military area for the next 55 years
- Last foreign troops left
   Paldiski in 1994

- Paldiski is the second biggest town in Estonia
- Inhabitants: 3800


#### Paldiski South Harbour
