#### II Description of the objectives, impact and main activities of the cooperation project

### **Objectives:**

- to educate communities and visitors of sustainable use of nature for recreation and food-production
- to offer activities for local people and invite visitors to participating regions in low season

#### **Activities:**

- raising awareness of dark sky in each partner area's
- setting up Dark Sky Academy's
- working with local businesses to introduce new ideas, promote dark sky activities and to attract visitors with marketing support

#### **Expected outcomes:**

- Local communities and visitors' knowledge and about light pollution and its impact on nature and people is increased
- Dark Sky Academies are set up in all regions and are cooperating with each other
- Number of visitors to the regions in increased
- Incomes of local businesses have increased
